

Elder Russell C. Bell

Elder Russell Clark Bell was born the second of three children to the late Mr Johnnie Lewis Bell and the late Mrs Areatha (Ferrell) Bell on June 15, 1961 in Buffalo, New York.

Russell Bell was saved and filled with the Holy Ghost on Saturday, October 27, 1972 during a Pastor and Wife's anniversary celebration of the late Supt. Arsell Bell (Youth Night) at the age of 11. As a youth growing up at State Tabernacle Russell Bell attended Sunday School, Young People Willing Workers Class (YPWW), and Bibleband. He also sang in and directed the Junior Choir. Brother Russell was appointed Jr. Deacon, YPWW teacher and later became the Men's Sunday School teacher.

Called to the gospel ministry in 1986, he was ordained an Elder in 1992 by Bishop Leroy R. Anderson. He served as an Assistant Pastor to the late, beloved Supt. Arsell Bell Sr. Additionally he was president of the Young Men's Christian Council as well as the chairman of our annual Men's Day. Elder Russell loves to attend District meetings, State and National conventions around New York State and throughout the country.

Elder Russell Bell was married to the late Karen Yancey-Bell for eight years before her sudden demise on October 26, 2005.

He was appointed Pastor of State Tabernacle COGIC on December 21, 2007 by Bishop James R. Wright Sr., Jurisdictional Prelate of New York Western First Ecclesiastical Jurisdiction of the Churches of God in Christ worldwide.

He married Tracey Sherrod of New Jersey on October 17, 2009. October 2009 also marked the first pastoral anniversary celebration for Pastor Bell.

In December of 2009 Pastor Bell was appointed to the Bishop's Council of New York Western First Jurisdiction.

Sister Tracey started at an early age attending church with her grandparents Pastor George and Mother Ruth Sherrod, along with other family members on both sides. She started at her mother's family church, Mt. Zion Baptist Church where she loved going to Sunday School and singing in the youth choir. It was there during a revival meeting that she was saved in 1978 at the age of 9 years old. Later that year she asked her mother to come to Sunday service with her. As a result of that her mother ended up getting saved and Holy Ghost filled that day. Her father ended up getting saved within a couple of months.

Sister Tracey along with her parents left the Baptist church and ended up going to her uncle's church under the leadership of Bishop Floyd Sherrod, Emmanuel True Temple Inc., where Jesus Christ and holiness were taught. She was active in the choir, youth and outreach ministries and eventually became a devotional/ praise & worship leader. She would also travel with her parents as they evangelized locally and in different states. In 1989 she became ordained as a Missionary under Bishop Sherrod. She always loved the Lord, and God's people. She loved being in the background servicing and always liked to help people and help around the church as needed. Her years of service at Emmanuel True Temple, allowed her to be able to service, become a praise leader and minister the word, under the leadership of her parents Pastor Harold and Lady Betty Sherrod, of Mount Olive Rising Star Pentecostal Church in New Jersey until she moved to Buffalo on September 23, 2009.

Sister Tracey knew Pastor Russell C. Bell as a young child and didn't know that later the Lord had other plans for their lives. The Lord allowed them to meet again in 2008 and spoke great things concerning ministry and marriage. He said that he was going to do things very quick and bring this marriage together and he did just that! Pastor Russell Bell and Sister Tracey Sherrod married on October 17, 2009 at State Tabernacle COGIC, where they love the people. Sis Tracey is here to love her husband and to love, encourage, help out and minister to the natural and spiritual needs of the people, where she wants to see State Tabernacle and the community blessed beyond measure!


> The Sunday School Recognizes Losses





Crystal is a member of the Bible Club at ECC and drills for the Gospel Difference Drill Team.

Missionary Charlesetta Peace has been very instrumental shaping the life values and future for Crystal. Crystal wrote, "My new mommy (Missionary Peace) instilled in me the right way to live. Every morning before school I would get up and read a verse out of the bible and be able to memorize and recite it before I left the house for school. In the summer I would go to vacation bible school and when I go home I had to be able to tell something that I learned."

Crystal said she began to resist going to church during middle school years not realizing that it would help prepare her for the real world. Because of going to church she knows that when things get rough she can pray about her situation rather than turning drugs and alcohol like so many of her peers. She also state that no matter how she strays God always pulls her back and she is thankful for the ways he is using her .

Crystal is a single mom who has not allowed this to stop her from pursuing her goals. Crystal says, "Train up a child in the way he should go, and when he is old he shall not depart from it. This verse is not only in my mind but also in my heart. I have to remember this scripture persistently in order to raise my own son. 
